- I. Opening Statements (2 minutes each)
 - a. Prepare a brief statement summarizing your argument.

- II. Plaintiff's Main Argument (8 minutes)
 - a. Present the main facts of your case here.

- III. Defendant's Main Argument (8 minutes)
 - a. Present the main facts of your case here.

- IV. Plaintiff's Rebuttal (5 minutes)
 - a. Please limit this time to new facts, issues, and defenses raised in Defendant's argument.

- V. Defendant's Rebuttal (5 minutes)
 - a. Please limit this time to new facts, issues, and defenses raised in Plaintiff's argument.

- VI. Closing Statements (2 minutes each)
 - a. Present closing remarks, and anything else you feel you did not get to express in your argument or that Judicial Board should consider in making its decision.

- VII. Questions on behalf of the Judicial Board

*Note: The Judicial Board will determine, prior to the hearing, whether the issue at hand is a matter of fact or a matter of law and will notify both parties shortly before the scheduled hearing.
