Under Article 9 § 3(b)(2) of the Constitution of ASUCI, the Student Advocate General is empowered to "To impose appropriate structural measures on ASUCI offices such as mandating more training or better record management;" It is within that authority that the following is ordered.

In light of the investigation report compiled by the Internal Student Advocate General with regards to a complaint filed, the Academic Affairs Vice President is hereby directed to accommodate representatives from the Office of the Student Advocate General at certain meetings for a period of three weeks immediately following the passing of this order.

After the observation concludes, The Office of the Student Advocate General shall provide feedback and constructive criticism about their observations to the Executive Director and the AAVP.

This includes:

All-Staff Meetings

AAVP CORE Meetings

Any other meeting that the Student Advocate General, in consultation with the Academic Affairs Vice President, may deem necessary.

The following clarifications are made:

If the Academic Affairs Vice President deems a certain portion of any meeting to be confidential, the observers shall be obligated to leave the meeting for that portion of the meeting only.

Observers shall be from the Office of the Student Advocate General and be appointed by the Student Advocate General.
